Figures 1–4 show the features of the P and non-P corpora defined by scholars and not those extracted from the partition of the algorithm. However, as the two partitions overlap for the most part, this makes little difference to the result. Comparing the two results, some of the misattributions could be explained. For example, the name "Adam" is considered by the algorithm as P and the name "Jacob« as non-P. This explains why a part of Genesis 2–3 was considered as P and why almost all of Jacob story to non-P.
